### Our Weekly Teaching Offer

Our curriculum is multi-sensory, inclusive and well sequenced, designed to meet Filey's needs.

- **EYFS pupils** - receive art lessons with lots of opportunities to explore a range of art media and materials. In EYFS art is child-initiated and based around current interest within the class. Pupils have the opportunity to be creative and use their imaginations both in the classroom continuous provision and on a larger scale in the outdoor areas. They are taught how to use a range of art and design tools and materials.
- **Year 1 pupils** - receive weekly art lessons in alternating half terms. This follows the school long term planning and bespoke art and design progression document which is rooted in the National Curriculum for Art and Design for KS1. They also use the well resourced art area in the classroom independently.
- **Year 2 pupils** - receive weekly art lessons in alternating half terms. This follows the school long term planning and bespoke art and design progression document which is rooted in the National Curriculum for Art and Design for KS1.
- **In ALL classes** art consists of pupils being taught the knowledge of different art tools and techniques and being given the opportunity to use their imagination to be creative.

### Additional Opportunities for Art throughout School Life

All classes in school contribute to the whole school advent calendar by designing the creating the hidden images.

All classes in school contribute to the Filey Fishtive Festival display in the local community by creating artwork to be added to the display board which is displayed in the local community at Christmas time. All Year 2 children create a poppy which is taken to the Local Memorial Garden to be displayed. All children in school create cards for celebrations throughout the year including Christmas and Easter. All children create their own calendar which they share with their parents and carers at Christmas time. Children also have opportunities to share and celebrate their artwork as part of their class Enterprise.

### Art Club

Our Year 2 and Year 1 children have the opportunity to attend art club with Miss Haldenby during the school year.

Year 2 art club- Every Tuesday  
lunchtime Autumn term to Spring 1  
Year 1 art club- Every Tuesday  
lunchtime Spring 2 to Summer 2.



### Assessment

Children are assessed regularly throughout the unit of learning using the bespoke school progression document for art and design. This assessment is recorded on the Medium term planning by each class teacher. Learning is continually revisited through planned time for retrieval during each art and design lesson.

### Class Provision includes:

- Paints and paintbrushes
- A range of drawing implements including pastels, charcoal, pens, pencils
- Clay and clay tools
- A range of papers, glue and scissors
- Fabric, needles and thread
- Printing materials
- Images of artwork by a range of artists.

### Art Gallery

All class in school contribute to our Art Gallery display in the central corridor in school. This is celebration of the wonderful artwork produced by children throughout school.
