Our Weekly Teaching Offer

Our curriculum is multi-sensory, inclusive and well sequenced, designed to meet Filey's needs.

- EYFS pupils receive DT lessons with lots of opportunities to explore a range of DT tools and techniques. In EYFS DT is child-initiated and based around current interest within the class. Pupils have the opportunity to be creative and use their imaginations both in the classroom continuous provision and on a larger scale in the outdoor areas.
- Year 1 pupils receive weekly DT lessons in alternating half terms. This follows the school long term planning and bespoke design and technology progression document which is rooted in the National Curriculum for Design and Technology for KS1. They also use the well-resourced workshop area in the classroom independently.
- Year 2 pupils receive weekly DT lessons in alternating half terms. This follows the school long term planning and bespoke art and design progression document which is rooted in the National Curriculum for Design and Technology for KS1.
- In ALL classes- DT consists of pupils being taught the knowledge of different DT tools and techniques and being given the opportunity to use these tools and techniques when designing and making.

Additional Opportunities for DT throughout School Life

All classes in school contribute to designing and making Nativity boxes which are delivered to the local community at Christmas time.







Assessment

Children are assessed regularly throughout the unit of learning using the bespoke school progression document for Design and Technology. This assessment is recorded on the Medium term planning by each class teacher. Learning is continually revisited through planned time for retrieval during each Design and Technology lesson.
