Music at Filey

Intent

At Filey Church of England Nursery and Infants Academy we make Music an inclusive, enjoyable and exciting learning experience. We provide opportunities for all children to compose, perform and play. Singing is the core of Music at our school, which is celebrated in our weekly singing collective worship.

Children collaborate to learn about the structure and organisation of the Music dimensions and experience the joy of performance. We encourage the children to participate in a variety of musical experiences, which allow them to develop their self-esteem, confidence and christian core values.

Implementation

Our music curriculum is progressive and follows the Jolly Music Scheme. We also have a Listening curriculum to ensure children are exposed to a wide range of rich, diverse music. Our long term plan ensures coverage of the musical dimensions and children have the opportunity to embed these knowledge and skills. We plan lessons to build upon the children's prior learning, whilst giving all abilities the opportunity to develop their skills, knowledge and understanding. Within our whole class teaching, children experience a wide range of musical opportunities with regards to appraising. composing and performing, whilst also being exposed to a variety of

composers and music.

Impact

The outcomes of Music can be seen with video recorded evidence, which we use to track the development of and knowledge of our children's musical ability. We want our children to develop a love of music, including composing, singing and performing. Alongside this, we aim to provide many occasions for children to participate in a range of wider musical opportunities both in school and during extra-curricular activities. This gives our children the chance to increase their confidence whilst simultaneously developing their love to perform.
