Our Weekly Music Teaching Offer

Our Music curriculum is multi-sensory, inclusive and well sequenced, designed to meet Filey's needs. It is designed using the National Curriculum, Model Music Curriculum (MMC) and New National Plan for Music.

- **EYFS pupils** - receive music lessons based on traditional rhyme and song with lots of opportunities to explore instruments, sing and perform. Music in EYFS is child-initiated and based around current interest within the class. Children in Reception perform whole class using body percussion.
- **Year 1 pupils** - receive a 30 min Music lesson which follows the Jolly Music scheme. There is also the opportunity for a range of untuned percussion performances throughout the year. KS1 follow the school's bespoke listening curriculum which is inspired by the Model Music Curriculum.
- **Year 2 pupils** - Receive weekly music lessons following the Jolly Music Scheme. There is also the opportunity for a range of whole class tuned percussion performances throughout the year. KS1 follow the school's bespoke listening curriculum which is inspired by the Model Music Curriculum.
- **In ALL classes** music consists of listening, performing, composing & singing too.



Our Music collective worship

All pupils attend our 25 minute whole-school music collective worship once a week delivered by our Music Lead - Miss Withers. We use this as time to come together and sing. We also use this time to help our children prepare for our performances and events.

Playing instruments

All of our Y1 children have the opportunity to play an untuned percussion instrument and Y2 have the opportunity to play the bells (tuned percussion) and participate in whole class performances.

Y2 **choir** - every Tuesday after school

Y2 **recorders** - Every Thursday lunch from Spring 2
