

Nursery News

This week in nursery, the children have been playing in the snow, looking at winter pictures and making snowflakes. They have also been practicing their nativity songs and making props ready for the play. Make sure you get your tickets, you are in for a treat!

Reception News

This week, the Reception children have been busy getting ready for Christmas. They have made some wonderful decorations and their classrooms look very festive. In maths, they have been learning about patterns. They have made party hats with repeating patterns and created repeated patterns using paper chains. They have also been rehearsing for their Christmas Play and we are all very impressed with their enthusiastic singing.

Year One News

In Literacy this week, year 1 children have started their new key text 'The Christmas Story'. They made a list of the characters and used this to make their own Nativity scenes. They also sequenced story events ready to write their own Christmas story next week. In Maths, they have been focussing on 2D shapes. They went on a shape hunt around school and used sorting skills to sort different 2D shapes into groups. In Science, children have been looking at Autumn and have begun to investigate the five senses. They used their knowledge of both of these topics when they went on an Autumn walk to Glen Gardens. Photos from our Autumn walk are available on Twitter. In RE they read the parable 'Jonah the Groaner' and created a class book re-telling the story and in PSHE they learnt about the importance of hygiene and how to keep themselves and their homes clean. This week year 1 children also began to practice for their Nativity, 'The Twinkly Nativity'. Children with speaking parts have brought their lines home with them this week to practice at home.

Year Two News

This week, year 2 have been looking at the story 'White Night Farm' which is about two cousins, one is German and one is English. In the story, the two men end up fighting against each other in WW1. The story explores their feelings and shows their lives as children, young soldiers and then as old men once the war is over. The children have written a diary entry pretending to be one of these

soldiers and written about their life at each stage that the story covers. In maths, pupils have been looking at adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers. In RE, children have been preparing for advent. Christmas preparation has also begun and the children have been practising ready for our production of 'Hey EWE'.
