
Dear Parents/Carers

In Reception, we started our phonics learning this week and have learnt the sounds s,a,t and p. We have been reading the story 'The Colour Monster' and enjoyed sorting into colours, making patterns, role playing in the ice cream shop and playing with our friends in our outdoor area. We also had lots of fun at the art table painting self portraits. We are looking forward to starting our maths learning next week.

Year One News

This week Year 1 have continued their work using the book "Who am I". We have been sharing things that we enjoy doing and people who are special to us. In maths we have been comparing objects using vocabulary such as longer, taller, shorter, lighter and heavier. During science this week we learnt about garden plants and went for a hunt around the school grounds to identify some. In RE we have started thinking about belonging, sharing the different things that we belong to. During PSHE we discussed what we want our class to be like and created our own class rules. Finally in PE we have been practicing our agility skills to change directions quickly. This week we also began our in class Reading Practice sessions. Children will begin to bring reading books to share at home, they will all have one by the end of next week. We will also be starting to share books through our online Collins reading platform, please see reading records for log on details.

Year Two News

This week Year 2 have enjoyed exploring their new story 'Flotsam' in their literacy lessons. They shared the story and used adjectives and adverbs to describe the illustrations. In maths they have been learning about multiples of ten. During their history lesson they enjoyed finding out about what life was like in the past and what job flither girls had. During RE they shared the Islamic story of 'The Crying Camel.' In computing they created a poster to tell people how to stay safe online. In science they enjoyed investigating which part of the playground and field is a habitat for the most minibeasts.
