This week in nursery we have been talking about feelings and enjoying stories about how to talk about how we are feeling. We have made a conker wreath to display on the door and have also practised our Autumn song 'Autumn leaves are falling down.' We enjoyed our sponsored walk in the sun and had a well deserved ice lolly to celebrate.

#### **Reception News**

In Reception this week we have continued exploring the story 'Elmer' and enjoyed making our own patterned Elmer patchworks. In Maths we have been learning all about the number 2. We have also started to practise our harvest song for the Harvest Festival next Friday. We also enjoyed our school sponsored walk this afternoon, especially our ice cream treat!

#### **Year One News**

This week in maths year 1 have been learning about part part whole models and have been practising identifying the parts and wholes of objects and groups of objects. In Literacy we have been looking at what makes a good sentence, thinking about how most sentences have a who, what and where in them. We have been using this structure to verbally compose our own silly sentences. During RE we

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continued our learning about belonging by looking at different special things that people who belong to the religion of Islam may have or use. In science we have been learning about trees. We thought about the difference between deciduous and evergreen trees and learnt to use a leaf identification chart to identify trees. In geography we worked together to create a simple map of the classroom. On our trips next week we will be using the science and geography skills we have been practising this week! Just a reminder that children need wellies or boots and long trousers for the trip (trainers are ok but may get wet and muddy!).

### Year Two News

This week, Year 2 have enjoyed learning about harvest celebrations around the world. They have written some lovely harvest poetry using adjectives and expanded noun phrases. In maths they have continued their exploration of multiples of ten, using known number facts to help them with addition and subtraction of multiples of ten. In history they compared the seaside in the past to the seaside in the present. During geography they explored some of the physical and human features in Filey and thought about whether these features have a negative or positive impact. In PE they have been developing their skills of defending and attacking. They have also been learning harvest songs and thinking about what they are thankful for ready for our Harvest Festival next week.
