This week in Nursery we have enjoyed leaf painting and conker rolling. We had an Autumn walk to look for signs of Autumn and to pick the leaves for our art and craft activities. We have put our wonderful art work in the art corridor at school. It looks great!

Reception News

This week, Reception have continued to explore the book 'Super Duper You'. In 'Drawing Club' we have been thinking about what makes us special and unique and all the things that we enjoy. In Maths we have been exploring different representations of the number 4 and made our own '4 world'. We have also been thinking about the different people who help us in the community.

Year One News

This week year 1 has been focusing on the number 5 in maths. We have thought about different ways to make it and worked systematically to partition it. In Literacy Miss Ring's class have been busy preparing for their poetry assembly next week and Miss Ghorst's class have been writing about the story of The Storm Whale. In our RE we learnt about how Christians welcome a new baby with a Christening or Baptism and worked together to role play one. In Science we have started learning about the seasons by thinking about the things we can see around that tell us Autumn is coming. In PSHE we took part in some activities for World Mental Health Day. In Art we did some more drawings of beach huts inspired by local artist Deborah Barker this time using oil pastels. In Computing we learnt about what personal information is and how important it is to keep it safe.

Year Two News

This week, Year 2 have continued to enjoy the story, 'Dougal's Deep Sea Diary.' They have written their own diary entries, using adjectives, expanded noun phrases and different types of sentences. In maths they have explored place value in two digit numbers. They created different representations of two digit numbers and used what they know about place value to compare two digit numbers. In science they learnt more about habitats and microhabitats and enjoyed creating microhabitats for minibeasts. During DT they created a set of design criteria ready for designing their own model boat.
