In RE we have been thinking about the different groups we belong to within our community and in Music we have started to explore body percussion and the different ways we can make music with our body parts.

Year One News

Year 1 have had another busy week. In Literacy Miss Ring's Class have been practising performing their poetry assembly and have also been writing the story of The Storm Whale. Miss Ghorst's Class have been working together to write their poetry assembly. In maths we have been looking at partitioning smaller numbers. In RE we learnt about weddings and how people make promises to each other to show that they belong. In PE we have been practising our throwing and catching skills, and with Mr Ellis we have been learning about attacking and defending during team games. In music we have been performing sea shanties.

Year Two News

This week, Year 2 have enjoyed exploring their new class book 'Pandora' by Victoria Turnbull. They have used their comprehension skills to answer questions about the story and explored how the character and setting change throughout the story. In maths they have been finding different ways of partitioning 2 digit numbers and completing missing number equations. They have also practised adding 3 single digit numbers. During DT they created designs for their boats, labelling all of the features using their design criteria. They all enjoyed the geography field trip on Wednesday afternoon. They walked through Filey and spotted physical and human features and even enjoyed a delicious ice cream! During history they compared seaside holidays in the present to seaside holidays in the past.
