This week in Nursery we have been learning the rhyme 'Miss Molly had a dolly'. The sound of the week has been 'P'. Reception News

Reception have enjoyed continuing their learning all about Goldilocks and the three bears this week. In Literacy we have drawn the house for the 3 bears and made a map for the three bears to follow to find Goldilocks in the woods. In Maths, we have been looking at parts and the whole and in mastery we have been consolidating our understanding of the number 3. We have also been learning about remembrance day and enjoyed making poppy collages and paintings. In PSHE we have been thinking about the things that we are good at and what makes each of us incredible.

Year One News

Year 1 have launched into our new topic of Funny Bones. In literacy we started by reading the story and have been focusing on remembering to have capital letters and full stops on our sentences. In PE we used the story to think about different ways to move to pretend to be the characters in the book. In maths we have been learning about 3D shapes. We can identify cubes, cones, cuboids, spheres, cylinders and pyramids. In science we learnt about our five senses and their associated body parts. In computing we learnt that technology is anything designed by humans to help us and spotted technology without our classrooms. In DT we started our topic on healthy choices and sorted some different foods into fruits and vegetables. We celebrated anti-bullying week in PSHE, learning about what bullying is and thinking about how we can be kind friends. We have also started to learn our songs for our Nativity!

Year Two News

This week, Year 2 have been learning about World War One. In their history lesson they created a World Wars timeline. During their literacy lessons they wrote their own fact files with information about World War One. They visited the Memorial Gardens on Tuesday for the Remembrance Service. In art they created beautiful remembrance inspired artwork using sketching and pastels. Both classes have also enjoyed preparing for and presenting their poetry assemblies this week. In maths they have been learning how to find the difference between two numbers using subtraction. In their science lesson they explored objects and the materials they are made from and also discussed the properties of the materials. They thought about how to use their power for good as part of our Anti-Bullying Week activities.
