Reception have had a busy week getting ready for their nativity production next week. In Maths we have been learning all about repeating patterns and having a go at making our own. In Literacy we have started reading the story of 'StickMan'. We have also been looking at what Christmas and Christmas presents may have looked like in the past. We are really looking forward to performing our nativity next week.

Year One News

In literacy and RE this week the children have been looking at the Nativity Story and have been retelling this in the small world area. In Maths they have been looking at number lines, using their knowledge of 5 and a bit to plot missing numbers and comparing numbers to 10. In History the children have been creating their own timeline. In PSHE we looked at how the important people in our lives make us feel safe and loved. In RE we thought about the question What do Christians believe God is like? by listening to a variety of hymns. The Nativity practices are in full flow and the children cannot wait to perform for you next week.

Year Two News

This week Year 2 have enjoyed sharing the story 'The Christmas Truce' in their literacy lessons. They have explored the features of a letter and learnt more about writing in the first person. They also practised using conjunctions in their sentences. In maths they have been using number facts to ten to help them with adding and subtracting a one digit number and a two digit number. In science they investigated which solid objects can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. They have made decorations for the school Christmas tree. They enjoyed a live Lyfta lesson about compassion and empathy. They have also been very busy rehearsing for their Christmas Nativity play.
