This week Year 2 were very excited to have a visit from the Filey firefighters. The children had a look around the fire engine and found out about some of the equipment. They shared all of their knowledge about the Great Fire of London with the firefighters! In literacy they have been writing instructions about how to make honey. During their maths lessons they have been continuing to learn about fractions including halves, quarters and thirds. During their science lesson they explored why some materials are not suitable for making some objects. In PSHE they explored what makes them happy and healthy. In geography they compared the physical features in Filey with the physical features in Sydney. They also enjoyed a tennis session with a tennis coach in their PE lesson.
