Nursery News

This week in Nursery phonics we have been thinking about the sound qu as in queen, quack and quick. In maths we have been ordering numbers 1-5 and singing rhyming songs with numbers such as 5 little monkeys swinging in the tree and 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive. We have been holding our fingers up to show the numbers whilst singing. We have planted more green beans and have planted our sunflowers outside as the weather is warming up. In P.E we have practised our races again ready for Sports Day.

Reception News

In Maths this week, Reception have been learning to subtract within 10. We have been using a range of methods including blocks, tens frames, counting back in our head and using number lines. In Literacy we have been reading 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and thinking about what our magic egg could grow into. We have also been busy tending to the vegetables and flowers in our allotment. We are looking forward to returning to school after the half term holiday to begin our topic all about Pirates.



Year One News

Year 1 has had a busy but fantastic last week of term. Both classes held their enterprises this week sharing a video of their riddle poems and all of their animal inspired artwork. Thank you to those who were able to come along. In maths this week we have finished our unit of learning about addition and subtraction building our fluency of number facts within 10. In literacy we finished writing fact files about our favourite animals. In RE this week we looked at Christianity in Kenya. In PSHE we thought about being healthy and safe. We talked about medicine safety and being a hygiene hero. We hope you all have a lovely half-term!

Year Two News

This week Year 2 have been exploring grammar in their literacy lessons. They have focused on correct punctuation, different sentence types and how to write in the past tense. In maths they have continued to explore capacity and volume and they have also learnt about measuring temperature in degrees celsius. They practised using a ruler to accurately measure and draw lines. In science they observed how much their seeds have grown. They found out that the seeds with light, water, soil and warmth grew the tallest. In computing they have been debugging algorithms, using the beebots to help them. During their RE lesson they thought about what good news means to them. In their music lesson they enjoyed exploring pitch and creating their own short compositions using different pitches.
