Nursery News

This week in Nursery we have been thinking about the sound Y as in yellow and yoyo. We have been



looking at shape and trying to recognise numerals 1-10. We have enjoyed planting Poppy seeds, onion and garlic plants and are looking forward to watching them grow. We have played board games and thinking about sharing and why it is great to share and be kind to one another.

Reception News

Reception have had another busy week of learning. In Maths we have been counting within 100 and practising counting in tens. In Literacy we have been reading the story 'On the way home'. In RE we have been continuing our learning about special places, exploring different places of worship. In PSHE we have been thinking about hygiene and why it is important to wash our hands properly. We particularly enjoyed experimenting with water, glitter and soap to see the effect of soap in preventing germs from sticking to our hands.

Year One News

Year 1 have been continuing their learning about animals this week. In literacy they have practiced using question marks, exclamation marks and conjunctions in their writing. We are working towards using these when writing an animal fact file. In maths we have been consolidating our basic number facts focusing on finding a difference of 1 and 2. In Science we learnt about the key features of fish and birds and began to identify some common examples. We have also continued our art project working towards making an animal inspired print which will be shared at our enterprises in a few weeks time!

Year Two News

This week Year 2 have been very busy preparing for their class enterprises next week. They have thought about the changes they would like to see in the world and they have written their own speeches about a change that they believe in during their literacy lessons. In maths they have been learning about mass and they have used the scales to weigh items using grams and kilograms. They have enjoyed sewing their initials onto their beautiful printed bags. During science they observed the changes that have happened to the seeds that they are growing in different conditions. They have continued to explore algorithms in their computing lesson. They have practised their running, jumping and throwing skills during PE.
