In RE we have been looking at different bibles, exploring the similarities and differences between each of them. In PSHE we have continued our learning about our body, focussing this week on our senses. We are all looking forward to our outdoor trip to the beach on Tuesday.

Year One News

In History this week we have been learning about the explorers Captain James Cook and Ernest Shackleton. In Maths we have been looking at the relationship between doubling and halving. In science we have been investigating the parts of a tree. In computing we have been recapping forward and backwards and introducing left and right turns when programming the beetbots. In RE we have read the parable of the lost sheep and linked this to how we can care for everyone not only in our class, but in the world.

Year Two News

This week Year 2 have enjoyed sharing the story 'In Every House, On Every Street' in their literacy lessons and they have planned and written their own leaflets about our school. In maths they have been exploring data and they have looked at and created their own tally charts, tables, block diagrams and pictograms. During science they learnt more about what humans need to survive. In R.E. they learnt about sacred places and labelled parts of a Christian church. In geography they learnt about the compass points and during DT they sorted foods into their different food groups.
